

Purchasing quayside electricity and drinking water at Wijnegem waiting port

In the context of further greening of inland water transport, De Scheepvaart is investing in quayside electricity infrastructure on the Albert Canal. From 06/07/2015, inland waterway companies can make use of the waiting port of Wijnegem on the Albert Canal for topping up electricity and drinking water. Inland waterway skippers can also dispose of their household waste in closed waste containers.

In order to make use of these facilities, the user must make a one-off registration on <http://www.flanderslogistics.be/walstroom> and then click on request.

Payment for these services also takes place via this application. The price for electricity is 0.27 €/kWh.

The application is also available via the free Walstroom app, which is currently already available for android. It will shortly also become available for IOS.

All electricity and water points are in closed cabinets. These can be opened using a code that the user receives at the start of his session. In this way, all connection points are protected against vandalism. The cabinets are fitted with various types of plugs of the type CEE, mono phase 16a, three-phase 32 ampere and three-phase 63 ampere and a maximum of 32 ampere can be supplied. In this way, every user can be helped.
